Built to specifications for whale watching expeditions, Eye-Spy represents the ultimate in design, stability and technology. Six viewing decks and large bow with surrounding decks allow for unobstructed viewing. Floor to ceiling glass with air-conditioned comfort means staying inside will not hinder your viewing pleasure.

Enhanced seating along with excellent sea keeping qualities makes traveling to and from the whale sighting grounds both comfortable and enjoyable.

Fitted with low noise propellers to minimize noise, while electronically controlled engines reduce fuel usage and exhaust emissions all ensure MV Eye-Spy remains environmentally friendly to both the whales and all other marine life.

With a capacity to accommodate up to three hundred guests at any one time, MV Eye-Spy is also available for private charters, weddings and corporate functions.
